Child must turn 5 by September 1, 2018.

ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION MUST BE PROVIDED AT REGISTRATION: **(A, B & C)**

1) PROOF OF RESIDENCY IN BURRILLVILLE:

A) TWO (2) Current Utility Bills dated within 1 month of registration. (Bills must show your name and physical address, not a P.O. Box)

B) A Current TAX BILL OR MORTGAGE STATEMENT

C) Notarized Affidavit of Residency (*form will be provided at registration or can be found at www.bsd-ri.net*)

2) BIRTH CERTIFICATE (*ORIGINAL*)

3) IMMUNIZATION RECORD AND CURRENT PHYSICAL.

****All requested information must be received BEFORE a child can start kindergarten.***

Please bring your child with you as they will be screened by our Kindergarten Teachers and Child Outreach at registration or by calling Child Outreach at 647-7560 to make an appointment.

Welcome to Austin T. Levy School

- *The Austin T. Levy School is a primary school serving grades Pre-K, Kindergarten and Grade 1. Levy School currently houses a population of about 300 students, with four preschool sessions, seven kindergarten classes, and seven first grade classes.*

- *The school is staffed with certified teachers: 16 Classroom Teachers, 3 Special Education teachers, a Physical Education/Health Teacher, a Media Specialist, 2 Speech/Language Pathologists, a School Psychologist, a Reading Specialist, 2 part-time Math Specialists, and a full-time Principal.*



- *We share a Music Teacher, an Art Teacher, a Health/Technology Teacher, an Occupational Therapist, and a Physical Therapist with other schools in the district.*

- Students learn how to read and write in English/Language Arts, how to count, and problem solve in Mathematics, experiment in Science, and learn about the community around them in Social Studies. - In addition to these academic areas, students receive physical education where they use movement with an emphasis on noncompetitive activities and cooperative play.
- Students enjoy learning about music. They move fast, sing quietly, use different types of voices, pat the beat, clap the rhythm, and dance. The musical concepts covered in Kindergarten are very foundational; students need to have a good understanding of loud/soft, fast/slow, high/low, beat, and rhythm in order to move onto more difficult concepts in the following grade levels.



- Art is an area where students are able to express themselves! They say a picture is worth a thousand words. Here are some pictures our students have created.



- In library class at Levy, the students learn their way around the library and how to find books that are just right for their needs and curiosities. They learn how to appreciate a story for more than pictures or words on a page and how to use technology and books to find information. In Technology class, we begin building a foundation for safe, successful use from problem solving to coding to touch-typing.
