RE: Asbestos Management Plan availability notification

This notification is required by the Asbestos-Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA, 40 CFR Part 763 of Title II of the Toxic Substance Control Act).

Asbestos management plans have been developed for the following list of educational facilities, grades kindergarten through twelve, which may have asbestos-containing materials present. These plans are available and accessible at each individual facility as well as the Burrillville School Department administrative offices. The plans outline how asbestos-containing materials will be handled in each of the school buildings.

We are committed to maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all children, employees and visitors in our schools. We will continue to monitor, inspect and repair any asbestos containing materials. These plans are available and accessible at each individual facility as well as the Burrillville School Department administrative offices.

We will continue periodic surveillance to assess our physical environment every six months. These inspections occur in March and September of every year.
