**Burrillville School Department
Amended Partial Plan**

School begins on **September 14th** for all students, PK-12. All students will begin the year virtually. Staff will return to school buildings. Teachers will provide virtual instruction from their classrooms. If we begin in a partial opening, parents will have the opportunity to enroll their children in the **BDLA**.

On Tuesday, September 29th, we will begin the first phase of in-person return for students.

- All Kindergarten and Grade 2 students will return to school (except those whose parents have opted for the BDLA).
- All PK students with IEPs will return to school.
- All of our highest-need special populations in grades PK-12 will return to school.
- Grades 1, 3, 4, 5, and 6-12 will remain in distance learning.
- **MONDAYS WILL BE DISTANCE LEARNING DAYS FOR ALL STUDENTS, PK-12***

On Tuesday, October 13th, we will begin the second phase of in-person return for students.

- All PK students (community peers) will return.
- All students in grades 1, 3, 4, and 5 (except those whose parents have opted for the BDLA) will return to school buildings.
- All remaining students with IEPs in Grades PK-12 will return to school buildings.
- **MONDAYS WILL BE DISTANCE LEARNING DAYS FOR ALL STUDENTS, PK-12***

After October 13th, the district will continue to evaluate how/when students at the secondary levels may be able to return to school.

Calendar of return:

- **September 14** - Teachers return to classrooms to teach virtually
- **September 29** - The following groups of students will return to the school buildings: K, Gr 2, PK IEP students, High Need Special Education Students Grades K-12,
- **October 13** - Grades 1,3,4,5, and remaining Special Education students (all grades) return to school buildings. Grades 6-12 remain on distance learning.
 - Plans will be reviewed weekly to determine if our groups of students can safely re-enter school buildings. Additionally, BHS and BMS will investigate intermittent "lab days" for specific groups of students in specialized subject areas.

If at any time, there are health or safety concerns that cannot properly be addressed, we will pivot to a full distance learning model to ensure the safety of all students and staff.
