

ATTENTION 16 – 18 YEAR OLDS:

REGISTRATION FOR OUR MUNICIPAL COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINIC IS NOW OPEN!

Below are the links to register for our Burrillville Vaccine Clinics for residents ages 16 – 18. Our first clinic will be held on Tuesday, May 11th with after school hours. The follow up clinic for the 2nd vaccine dose will take place on Tuesday, June 1st. This will also run after school hours. Parents of residents age 16-18 are also eligible to register for the vaccine.

Please note: Per Rhode Island General Law (RIGL), parental permission for students age 16 and 17 is not needed. However, The Burrillville School Department strongly **encourages** all students age 16 and 17, to obtain approval or consent from their parents or legal guardians to receive the Pfizer Covid-19 vaccination. Notwithstanding RIGL 23-4.6-1, we believe parents and legal guardians should have a direct role in making such an important medical decision for their families.

Please review the information below prior to registering for the vaccine.

- All registrants will be receiving the Pfizer vaccine.
- Do not confuse the two links as an either/or situation. The first link – for Tuesday, 5/11/21, is for the FIRST dose. The second link, for Tuesday, 6/1/21, is for the SECOND dose.
- Registration, especially for the first clinic, should be done as soon as possible.
- **Be sure to register for both doses. You should register for the first dose, close the browser and then follow the other link to register for your second dose.**
- During registration, there is a page about insurance information – you need to enter the type of insurance that you have (private, Medicare, etc.). You do not need to enter any insurance details.
- You should NOT arrive any earlier than 15 minutes prior to your scheduled appointments. For the clinic to run smoothly, it is important for all to follow this guideline.
- You do not need to bring anything with you to the clinic other than photo identification, which makes check-in quicker.
- The age of medical consent in Rhode Island is 16; parental permission is not required.
- Our clinic physician, Dr. John Lawrence, has asked me to pass along this serious request – we know that the students are very busy and may come directly from school or other activities for the vaccine, however, ***it is imperative that you are well hydrated and have something in your stomach prior to getting the vaccine.*** Please take the time to eat and drink something before arrival!
- Vaccine supplies are limited; please do not double book or make multiple appointments. **Registration is only for Burrillville Residents between the ages of 16 – 18.**
